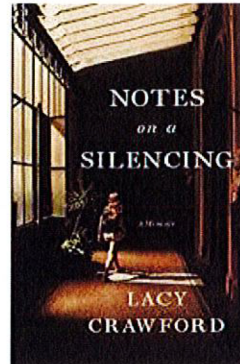


The Rogers Memorial Library presents
A Zoom Author Visit with Lacy Crawford,
author of **NOTES ON A SILENCING**



Wednesday, October 7, 2020, at 5:30 p.m.

When the elite St. Paul's School came under state investigation after extensive reports of sexual abuse on campus, Lacy Crawford thought she'd put behind her the assault she'd suffered when she was fifteen. Still, when detectives asked for victims to come forward, she reached out, and saw for the first time evidence that corroborated her memories – of the naïve, hardworking girl she'd been, a chorister and debater, the daughter of a priest; of the two senior athletes who assaulted her and graduated with awards; and of the faculty, doctors, and priests who had known about Crawford's assault and gone to great lengths to bury it.
