

Open Meetings

The Southold Free Library is subject to Open Meetings Law. This law requires that board meetings are properly posted, advertised, and open to the public.

Minutes of all board meetings are required by the Open Meetings Law. Minutes should be kept in a secure but accessible place and available to the public upon request. Draft minutes will be posted on the Library's web page, southoldlibrary.org, within two weeks of the meeting.
