

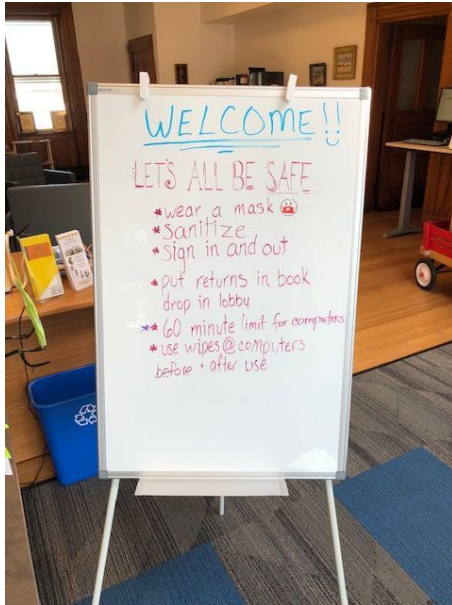

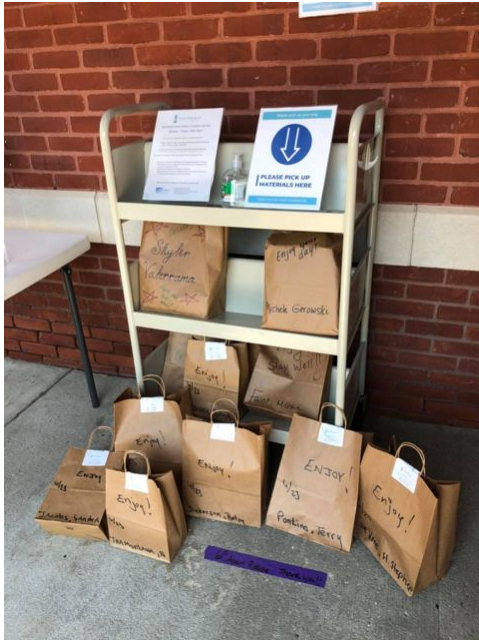

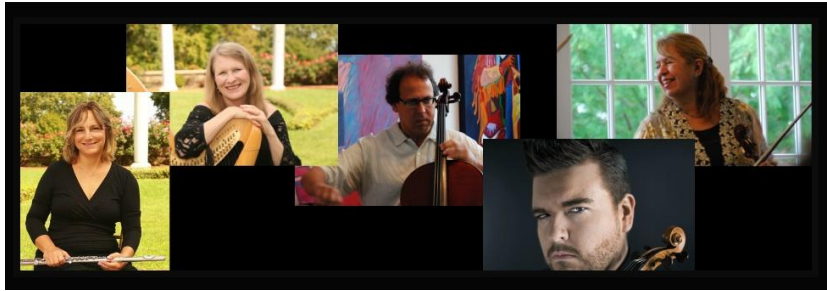
The magazines you know and love, available digitally.

Total downloads 25,629

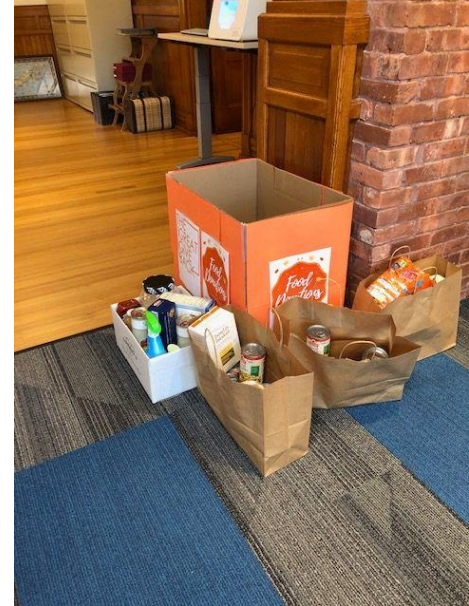
Policy change included becoming 'fine free'

food collected for local pantries...	



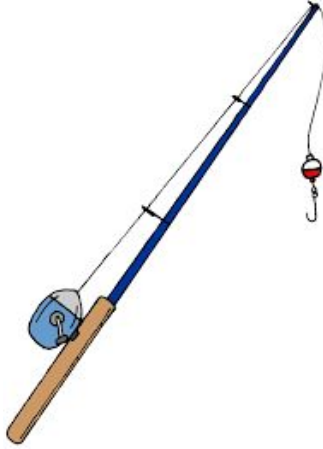
