Discussion was held on Mr. Tom, and it was decided due to his living out of town currently he would not be a good fit however due to his expertise and knowledge it was decided to ask him if he would be interested in an advisory capacity of some sort with the president. Mr. Hudgens to be interviewed next week.

Grants - no report

Buildings and Grounds – N. Antonucci reported in regard to the Masonry repairs. the masons said it would be unsafe to set up scaffolding or use ladders for this particular job. The reason is that the library is a public building with too much foot traffic in the area. As a result, they will need to use a lift to complete the repair safely.

Once the masons inspect the roofline, they will determine if it is just the flashing in the corners of the roof that needs repair. If this is the case, the repair will take one day to complete, and

the total cost for the repair will be \$2,100. If, on the other hand, the masons determine that the entire roofline requires repair, an additional \$3,200 cost is incurred, and it would take two days to complete. The total for the repair would then be \$5,300. (\$2,100 + \$3,200 = \$5,300) The masons will also remove the sapling growing out of the chimney and reseal the brickwork to prevent any such growth from happening again. N. Antonucci brought up possibly placing some type of amphitheater on the grounds. Discussion was held and it was decided to take an overall look at our property and then decide what would fit in.

New Business – The President thanked the Board for allotting the time to meet with her as the respective chairs of the committees prior to the meeting. She would like to continue doing so and it can be in person, coffee, breakfast, on a walk, etc. or via phone, text or email
