DISPLAYS: We had holiday books on display this month.

PROGRAMS: (We had 7 programs this month with 177 participants)

Fridays, December 1, 8, 15, 22, & 29: "Playgroup"—The Southold Mothers' Club continued coming in to play on Friday mornings in the children's room (10-11am). We had 80 little ones and their parents/caregivers come in this month.

Saturdays, December 2, 9, & 16: "Zumba Kids Junior"—Joanne Vitiello continued her exercise series for grades K-2 (10:00-10:30am). We had 13 little ones and their parents/caregivers come in this month.

Wednesday, December 6: "Mixed Media Gingerbread Houses"—Kristen Duer shared a beautiful, festive art idea for kids in grades 3-6 to make for the holiday. The kids painted a gingerbread house on a canvas and then added decorative items such as ribbon, candies, and cotton ball snow. They all looked absolutely gorgeous. 9 happy children came to decorate their houses in this unique, crafty keepsake way.

Friday, December 8: "Holiday Faire"—Jen McGreevy, Darlene Siracusano, Penny, and I showed children of all ages how to make cute, festive ornaments, gift boxes, centerpieces, and homemade cards. 25 children had a great time getting ready for the holidays.

Tuesday, December 12: "Steps to Success: Pasta Noodle Christmas Tree Ornaments" with CAST—My December program with CAST was an ornament making, festive craft. We used triangle tree and circle cardboard cut outs as a sturdy backing to glue colored pasta on with tacky glue. I colored macaroni and curly pasta with metallic acrylic paint, (green, red, gold, and white). 20 enthusiastic children glued different patterns of colored pasta on their ornament for a textured look and then we read a story and enjoyed an animal cracker snack with gingerbread dip that I made.
